When this sister saw the Ripolls selecting clothing from their inventory for her son, she broke down in tears. The Ripolls also selected clothing for the other young man who had, in Antonio's word, 'the face of a child on his birthday'. As he approached their door to leave their home, he squeezed the bags of clothes in his hands with a face of pure joy and happiness.*
